

RV & Travel Trailer Rental Options for the FALL 2024 Camp Plymouth

Rental terms are the same as for past events.

Many people would like to stay at the 49er Village RV Resort during our two swap meet shows because of the amenities, but they don't have a recreational vehicle, travel trailer, or camper truck, which the 49er requires. Cabins are usually available for the Fall meet but not the Spring one. Tenting is not allowed there, which is why we rent part of the fairgrounds for a tent campground. It is possible to find RV owners who will rent their unit via [Craigslist.org](https://www.craigslist.org) or social media. This article will mention other ways for renting a travel trailer or RV..

Renting From a Commercial Rental Company

If you want to rent a unit near your home, put belongings into it, drive or tow it to the event, and reverse steps at the end, you can do an online search to find commercial vendors or private owners in your area. We will only make one recommendation. An option is finding a rental company that will deliver a travel trailer to Plymouth, set it up, and pick it up at the end of the event. Some of our participants have had success doing this with Advantage Caravans in nearby Sacramento. Advantage is again offering a 20% discount from published daily rental fees for Camp Plymouth Spring or Fall event participants! This is not valid at other times. Their website is www.advantagervrentals.com. Owner Alex is at 916-832-8824. The online procedure is to book a reservation and in the Special Requests field, type that you are a participant going to the Camp Plymouth military vehicle event and request the 20% discount, and if you want it delivered/set up/picked up for the discounted \$150 round trip fee. After your request is received, a confirmation will be emailed which shows the fees and it will reflect the discount. You may also book over the phone.

It is easy to find what you want on their website. For example, I searched for trailers and a choice of units popped up, with a picture, price, and how many they sleep. I clicked on a 24' Trail Lite trailer for \$100 per night (discounted fee would be \$80) and this is what displayed. When a thumbnail picture is clicked, it starts a slide show. A floor plan diagram is available, and details are listed including amenities.

If you ask for a trailer to be delivered, you do not have to be there. Give them your 49er Village site number, ETA, and departure date and time ahead of the date. Then show up and your trailer will be there. Renting this way means you can drive your truck or car, bring your MV and/or load of sales goods. It is a military vehicle show and swap meet after all!

Renting from a Rental Broker

Here are two popular brokers who run websites that help RV and trailer owners rent their units: www.RVShare.com and www.Outdoorsy.com. Some commercial companies list units on these sites too, but most are privately owned. Sort for dates, RV or towable, driving or having it delivered, and location to search. A group of units will display plus a map showing where they are near the location you ask for. For example, here is a screen shot from Outdoorsy.com. I searched

for trailers near Plymouth and owners who offer delivery. Many are displayed and the map to the right shows Plymouth in the center and where each unit is. When you click on a picture the details and many pictures of that unit are shown. All terms and fees are shown (like "No Burning Man."). Delivery fee is usually based on mileage. If you want to tow or drive it, search a location near you. It is possible to message the owner with questions.

There is a fee to the broker site and for insurance, even for a static rental. Advantage Caravans does not charge for insurance. It might be cheaper to rent directly from a company that owns the units because of this and no middleman.

One nice thing about RV and trailer camping at these meets is you can choose your location in the 49er Village. Camp next to friends, near a restroom, the pond, or the café/store/pool/spa. The total cost could be less than a cabin.
