RV & Travel Trailer Rental Options for Camp Plymouth 2024

Many people would like to stay at the 49er Village RV Resort because of the shade and amenities, but they don't have a RV, travel trailer, or camper, which the 49er requires. Cabins rarely become available. Tent camping is not allowed there, which is a reason we rent part of the fairgrounds for tenting. It is possible to find RV and trailer owners who will rent their unit via Craigslist.org or social media. Here we will mention other ways for renting a unit for staying at the 49er.

Renting From a Commercial Rental Company

If you want to rent a unit near your home, put belongings into it, drive or tow it to the event, and reverse steps at the end, you can do an online search to find commercial vendors or private owners in your area. We will only make one recommendation. Consider a rental company or individual who will <u>deliver a travel trailer to Plymouth</u>, set it up, and pick it up at the end of the event. Besides not having the hassle of driving a rental RV or pulling a trailer and logistics related to that, you can drive your pickup towing your car hauler, MV, and trade goods, and your rental trailer will be waiting for you in your RV site. Please bring your MV if you have one, and things to sell!

Some of our participants have had success doing this with Advantage Caravans in nearby Sacramento. <u>Advantage</u> is again offering a **20% discount** from published daily fees for Camp Plymouth participants! This is not valid at other times. Their website is www.advantagervrentals.com. Owner Alex is at 916-832-8824. The online procedure is to request a reservation and in the Special Requests field, type that you are a participant going to the Camp Plymouth military

vehicle event and request the 20% discount. After your request is received, a quotation will be emailed which shows the fees and it will reflect the discount. You may also book over the phone with Alex.

When you search, a choice of units pops up, with a picture, price, and how many they sleep. For example, click on a 24' Trail Lite that was listed at \$100 per night (discounted price is \$80) and this screen displays. Click a thumbnail picture and a slide show starts. A floor plan diagram is often available, and details are listed including amenities. Alex might offer deeper discount on certain \$100 trailers.

This company will deliver the unit to the RV site you say, set it up, and pick it up on the days required, for \$150 for the round trip for Camp Plymouth renters only. Normal price is \$250.

Renting from a Broker

Here are two popular broker websites that help RV and trailer owners rent their units: www.RVShare.com and

www.Outdoorsy.com. Some commercial companies list units on these sites too, but most are privately owned. You sort for dates, RV or towable, driving or having it delivered, and location to search. There are RVs, conventional travel trailers, pop-ups, even toy haulers for your jeep or Mule. A group of units will display plus a map showing where they are near the location you ask for. For example, to the right is a current screen shot from Outdoorsy.com. We searched for trailers near Plymouth and owners who offer delivery. Many are displayed on a map around Plymouth. When you click on a unit on the map or the

photo of it, the details and many pictures of that unit are shown. All terms and fees are shown (like "No Burning Man."). Delivery fee is up to the owner and usually based on mileage. If you want to load it at home and drive or tow it, search near your home. It is possible to message the owner with questions.

There is a fee to the broker site and for insurance, even for a static rental (Advantage Caravans does not have a line item for insurance and there is no commission fee). It might be cheaper to rent directly from a company that owns the units because of no middleman.

• A nice thing about RV and trailer camping at this event is you can have amenities much like a cabin but can choose your location in the 49er Village. Camp next to friends, near a restroom, the pond, or the café/store/pool/spa. The total cost can be less than for a cabin. It is nice to park, sleep, and cook at the event rather than commute from a hotel.

For the 49er Village sites in our discount block, she puts your name on one, then you contact them to pay. Do not go through the 49er reservation system.
