

Rental Golf Carts for Camp Plymouth SPRING 2025 Meet

“They’re Baaaaack!”

As a service to our participants, rental golf carts will again be available from Gipson Golf Carts for our April 16 through 19, 2025 event in Plymouth. They will deliver to and pick up from our event for no fee. These will save some shoe leather. If you have not been to any of our events in Plymouth, it is a physically large venue. It is two-sided with our participants camping in RVs, campers, travel trailers or in cabins at the 49er Village, with tents and truck campers across the fence at the Amador County Fairgrounds where our Tent Sector, parking lot, trailer storage, and showcase arena are.

Jeeps, Mules, and golf carts are popular due to the distance we travel to shop and see all MVs and vendors. New ones show up daily. There is very little parking inside the 49er Village, and there is no parking allowed along the lanes and roads in either of our campgrounds or in empty campsites because they might not be empty for long (vehicles in the wrong campsites may be towed). But with a small vehicle it is usually easy to find a camper who will allow you to temporarily pull into their site while you shop or socialize nearby. Normally there is no room to do that with a car or truck.

As in the past, carts must be pre-reserved and are subject to availability. Contact Gipson directly before the event at 916-806-0920 to reserve one and do the rental agreement. The MVCC is not in the middle. We called several companies and found the best deal for you. Four passenger, electric, flip flatbed carts will be \$65 per day for a three-day minimum rental. There will be no delivery or pickup fee at this April event! Carts are typically delivered to a space next to the 49er office, where keys are issued, but this might change if and when the 49er rearranges their entrance drive and office location.

Again, carts must be pre-reserved. Gipson will not likely have a person there offering new rentals. If you want a cart delivered before Wednesday, best do your deal early so they can plan. They have an efficient delivery quantity of six, so if enough people want one on, say, Tuesday, they will probably send a trailer load then.

To cancel a reservation, call them at least 48 hours before our event. You will receive a refund, less a small processing fee. Very friendly! If any questions, Zack Bowden is their manager.
