

(Major hostilities of World War I were formally ended at the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month of 1918 with the German signing of the Armistice.)

The holiday is commonly printed as Veteran's Day or Veterans' Day in calendars and advertisements. While these spellings are grammatically acceptable, the United States government has declared that the attributive (no apostrophe) rather than the possessive case is the official spelling.

There will be many Parades and ceremonies on Nov. 11, I hope everyone gets to celebrate, even be in a Parade or two. There will be Parades in Sacramento, Oroville, Marysville, San Jose and Petaluma. I think there may even be one in Hawaii.

I got a call from a very nice gentleman in Hawaii who asked. What is NARA under some of the photos in the superbly produced MVCC News Letter, stand for? Well here is the answer. NARA stands for **National Archives and Records Administration**. I thank you for your Kind words and for your question. Please remember to turn your clocks back on Nov 6., so you won't miss Voting day on Nov 8. I wish everyone a Happy Thanksgiving.





# AFTER ACTION REPORT

## MVCC Member Attends Commemoration of the Allied Landings in Southern France, August 1944 A Report From Herman Pfauter

The French this year had decided to pull their resources together, resulting in a 2-week non-stop rolling event from La Londe in the West to the Italian border in Monaco in the East. Beginning August 15, the day of the Landings in Provence code-named "Operation Dragoon" and ending August 30, our convoy of approximately 75 vehicles - including 4 tanks - participated in 8 or more commemorations, wreath-laying ceremonies and parades. We were treated to sumptuous meals, received some gas and overnight lodging in sports complexes or school gyms.

Wherever we went we were received with applause by large crowds - after all - August is the height of the tourist season along the French Riviera. Fortunately enough we were seldom stuck in traffic except in the jams we created.

The weather was gorgeous every day with temperatures in the eighties.

I could not participate in the liberation of Monaco due to other commitments but I covered almost 2,000 miles in 3 1/2 weeks, encountering only one minor problem I did solve and returning safely via Italy and Austria to Germany.
