

# RV & Travel Trailer Rental Options for the SPRING 2026 Camp Plymouth Military Vehicle Show & Swap Meet in Plymouth, CA, and the

## FALL 2026 Military Vehicle Show & Swap Meet aka “Camp Delta 2” near Isleton, CA

*Short summary for our regulars: we have the same discount with Advantage Caravans for 2026*

Many people would like the amenities of a RV or rental cabin, but they don't have a RV or the cabins are full. Consider renting a motor home or travel trailer! You can have it delivered where you want it, set up, and picked up by the owner! Show up with your sales goods and MV if you have one, and the unit is there! It is possible to find RV owners who will rent their unit via Craigslist.org, Facebook Marketplace, or other social media. This article will mention other options.

### Renting From a Commercial Rental Company

If you want to rent a unit near your home, put belongings into it, drive or tow it to the event, and reverse steps at the end, you can do an online search to find commercial vendors or private owners in your area. Some vendors will deliver, set up, and pick up for a fee.

Some of our participants have had success doing this for several years with Advantage Caravans in nearby Sacramento. Advantage is again offering a 20% discount from published daily rental fees for Spring or Fall event participants! This is not valid at other times. Their website is [www.advantagervrentals.com](http://www.advantagervrentals.com). Owner Alex is at 916-832-8824. The procedure is to book a reservation online and in the Special Requests field, type that you are going to whichever of these military vehicle shows it is and you understand the discount is 20%. If you want the unit delivered, set up, and picked up, state that and write that you understand that fee is **\$150 round trip**. (normally \$250). After your request is received, a confirmation will be emailed which shows the numbers including the discounts. You may book by phone.


See the units on their website. For example, I searched for trailers, and clicked on a 24' Trail Lite for \$100 per night (discounted fee would be \$80) and this is part of what displayed. Price, how many it sleeps, and more. When a thumbnail picture is clicked, it starts a slide show. A floor plan is usually available.

If you ask for a trailer to be delivered, you do not have to be there. Give them your site number, ETA, and departure date and time.

Other vendors include Cruise America: <https://cruiseamerica.com>, and El Monte RV Rentals: <https://www.elmonterv.com>. Both might have locations near you.

### Renting from an Internet Rental Broker

Here are two popular broker sites that help RV owners rent their units: [www.RVShare.com](http://www.RVShare.com) and [www.Outdoorsy.com](http://www.Outdoorsy.com). Some commercial companies list units on these sites too. Sort for dates, motor home or towable, driving or having it delivered, and location to search. A group of units will display plus a map showing where they are near the location you ask for. For example, here is a screen shot from Outdoorsy.com. I searched for trailers near Plymouth and owners who offer delivery.



Many are displayed and the map to the right shows Plymouth in the center and where each unit is. When you click on a picture the details and many pictures are shown. All terms and fees are shown (like “No Burning Man.”). Delivery fee is usually based on mileage. It is possible to ask the owner questions.

There is a fee to the broker site and an insurance fee, even for a static rental. Advantage Caravans does not charge for static rental insurance. It might be cheaper to rent directly from a company that owns the units because of no middleman.
